

Interested in Becoming Catholic?

At the 9:00 am Mass on Sunday, October 12, nearly three dozen people took part in the Rite of Entrance into the Order of Catechumens and Rite of Welcome of Previously Baptized Christians and Baptized but Uncatechized Catholics (and that is the actual name - whew!).

This recognition by Fr. Dury and the Assembly at Mass began the formal formation part of the Order of Christian Initiation (OCI), which leads to their reception of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, both at the Easter Vigil and throughout the year.



Renewing the Grace of the Sacrament of Matrimony

Our parish is renewing its efforts to help couples fully receive and live out the graces of the Sacrament of Matrimony.

Many couples married civilly—but not in the Catholic Church—have recently begun the process of Convalidation, where they exchange vows before a priest or deacon and two witnesses. Through this simple yet profound step, they become sacramentally married in the Church.

If either spouse was previously married and the former spouse is still living, a Declaration of Nullity from the Diocesan Tribunal is required beforehand. For help navigating prior marriages, please contact Paul Stokell, our Adult Formation Director at pstokell@stjohnsunbury.org.

Little Liturgical Lessons

We, Your Servants and Your Holy People...

When we gather for Mass, we enter into something far greater than ourselves. We're not passive spectators at a "performance," nor consumers of a "product." Liturgy is *our work*. We are the Body of Christ, assembled of "many parts" (1 Corinthians 12:12) to worship the Father, *through* the Son *in* the unity of the Holy Spirit. And like any living body, we work and function best when each member does its part.

Who Assists at Mass?

The term "assist at Mass" has a rich meaning. While all the faithful "assist" by their presence and active participation, the Church also designates particular roles of service—ministries that help the liturgy unfold with reverence, clarity, and beauty. Ministers assist not to replace the assembly, but to help it flourish. How many do we need? The Church offers guidelines, but the answer depends on the size of the assembly, the nature of the celebration, and the resources of the parish. The goal is not to multiply roles for their own sake, but to serve the needs of the assembly with grace and simplicity.

The priest presides in the person of Christ the Head (*in persona Christi capitis*), and the deacon assists in proclaiming the Gospel and preparing the altar (in persona *Christi servus*). But the liturgy is not theirs alone. It is the work of the whole Church. The Second Vatican Council reminds us that "full, conscious, and active participation" *Sacrosanctum Concilium*) is the *right and duty* of all the baptized.

Greeters are often the first ministers people encounter—and their role is more than logistical. A greeter offers a warm welcome, a smile, and sometimes a handshake or word of encouragement. They embody the hospitality of Christ, especially to newcomers, the elderly, or those returning after time away. They also help maintain order and flow. They assist with seating, guide the Communion procession, take up the Offertory collection, and respond to any needs that arise during the liturgy. But their deeper role is pastoral: they help people feel at home, safe, and cared for. In case of an urgent matter in the assembly, they provide what's needed on the spot to preserve a safe and orderly environment. In a sense, they are ministers of presence—watchful, discreet, and kind.

What Does It Mean to "Make Room for Others" at Mass?

For us, making room is both literal and spiritual. Literally, it could be as simple as sliding over in the pew, offering a seat to someone who arrives late, or choosing a spot that doesn't block others. Spiritually, it means cultivating a heart that welcomes differences, forgives distractions, and embraces the messiness of community. We make room when we smile at a crying child rather than scowl. We make room when we greet someone unfamiliar, or when we refrain from judgment about how others dress, sing, or pray. We make room when we remember that every person present—no matter how broken or awkward—is a child of God, beloved, deserving of respect and invited to the same table.

Respect begins with attentiveness. Arriving on time, silencing phones (or tablets or toys), and participating fully are acts of love. Singing with the assembly, responding aloud, and listening to the readings are not just personal devotions—they are communal acts that build up the Church. Respect also means being mindful of space and silence. Avoiding unnecessary chatter, choosing modest and seasonal attire, and refraining from strong perfumes are small but meaningful ways to honor those around us. During Communion, we can be patient, prayerful, and aware of others' needs.

Above all, we respect our neighbor by remembering that we are not alone. Mass is not "my time with God"—it is our time with God. We come as one body, with many members, each bringing their joys and sorrows, each needing grace. When we assist, welcome, make room, and respect, we help the entire assembled body worship more deeply.
