


We're looking for Sponsors to accompany individuals exploring the Catholic faith through the OCI process.





SILENCE OR SPEAKING? COMMUNITY OR COMMUNION?

If there is a perfect place for silence and speech, it's in church. Spoken words are the medium for connection, praise, theological expression and proclamation, while silence offers us a space for connection to God, contemplation, humility and openness. The trick for Catholics – not to mention those who join us seeking a place to call their spiritual home–is to figure out what happens, and when! Our Church supplies guidance, most notably for the work of public worship, which we call liturgy.

The General Instruction to the Roman Missal, our "cookbook" for how Mass can (and should) be done, mentions plenty about silence and speech at Mass.

"The Liturgy of the Word is to be celebrated in such a way as to favor meditation, and so any kind of haste (that) hinders recollection is clearly to be avoided. In the course of it, brief periods of silence are also appropriate...under the action of the Holy Spirit, the Word of God may be grasped by the heart and a response through prayer may be prepared. It may be appropriate to observe such periods of silence, for example, before the Liturgy of the Word itself begins, after the First and Second Reading, and lastly at the conclusion of the Homily" (59).

The GIRM has just as much to say about the recitation of our Creed and the back-and-forth litany known as the Prayers of the Faithful (65-71).

In the Eucharistic Prayer, "the center and high point of the entire celebration," (78) silence and speech, listening and responding, are at their sharpest contrast. These words – all verbs! – describe what happens here: Thanksgiving, Acclamation, Epiclesis (blessing), Consecration, Anamnesis (remembering), Offering, Interceding (79 a-h). The rhythm of these parts and our own responses mirrors biblical encounters with God: Elijah hears God not in the wind or fire, but in a "still small voice" (1 Kings 19:12). The Communion Rite, with song and silence aplenty, helps us remain focused on why we're there, and Who we're with. If we know what's happening, how can we not listen, and at the right moments, how can we not sing out?

Behind all the words of the GIRM, though, is what our Church is telling us: Easy does it – you're talking to and listening to God. Take your time. Make the words uttered in God's house have value. Normalize pausing. Know that others pray with you.

Of course, public worship with our brothers and sisters will bring its own challenges: neighbors' cell phones, noisy youngsters, overly chatty friends, not to mention our own internal distractions. Like our personal prayer life, getting the most out of Mass takes practice – and heaps of patience and consideration for others. Silence and speech might not fit the way we want them to at Mass, but somehow it works. God is indeed praised, and to paraphrase 20th century monk and writer Thomas Merton, our own desire to please God does indeed please Him.






