


PRAY40 — JOURNEY TOGETHER IN PRAYER THIS LENT





WHAT IS AN INDULGENCE?

Indulgences have been making a welcome reappearance in the spiritual life of Catholics. After centuries of decline, punctuated by decades of neglect after the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965), the power of indulgences to enliven a sense of charity and to sharpen a healthy sorrow for sin is being rediscovered.

Today, indulgences are grouped into two types, partial and plenary, depending on whether they apply to some or all of the punishment for sins already forgiven. Indulgences are not, and never have been, ways to seek forgiveness for sins. Much less are they ways to get “permission” to sin in advance! The Church’s constant teaching should be clear: Indulgences can be applied only to the punishment that is due for sins already forgiven, either in Sacramental Confession (in the case of mortal or venial sins) or by personal expressions of sorrow (in the case of venial sins only).


Recent Popes have influenced the practice of indulgences. In 1968, Pope Saint Paul VI simplified the rules, encouraging Catholics to see indulgences as part of everyday life, not just special acts like pilgrimages. He emphasized that small daily sacrifices, like enduring rush-hour traffic, could become acts of reparation.

Pope Saint John Paul II revised the Enchiridion of Indulgences and extended indulgences to local events, recognizing the Akathist hymn in 1991 and offering a plenary indulgence for the Church’s millennial celebrations in 1998.

Pope Benedict XVI also granted indulgences, such as for those participating in the 150th anniversary of the Lourdes apparitions.

Indulgences have ancient roots in Christian life, with the term first used in the 11th century, though the practice dates back to early Church history during Roman persecutions. Christians suffering in prisons for the faith would sometimes send a letter to a bishop on behalf of a given penitent. The letter would ask the bishop, in recognition of the willingly accepted tribulations of the letter writer, to lighten the penance of a confessed and sorrowful sinner. These requests were a beautiful example of the faithful putting into practice one of St. Paul’s most famous admonitions: to “bear one another’s burdens” (see Galatians 6:2). This context showed the connection the Church always sensed between the Sacrament of Reconciliation and indulgences. To this day, the Catechism of the Catholic Church (nn. 1471-1479) and the Code of Canon Law (CIC 992-997) explain indulgences immediately in the context of Confession.

“Any Christian who, in a spirit of penitence for sins, asks God for the deeper share in the infinite merits of Jesus Christ that indulgences offer can use them to move ever closer to God — who wants nothing else than for us to be happy with Him forever.” (From an essay by Ed Peters, JCD, professor at Sacred Heart Major Seminary in Detroit).
