


We are pleased to welcome our new Director of Parish Administration, Chip Stalter, to the St. John Neumann parish staff.



Renewing the Grace of the Sacrament of Matrimony

Our parish is renewing its efforts to help couples fully receive and live out the graces of the Sacrament of Matrimony. Many couples married civilly—but not in the Catholic Church—have recently begun the process of Convalidation, where they exchange vows before a priest or deacon and two witnesses. Through this simple yet profound step, they become sacramentally married in the Church.

Little Liturgical Lessons

About that Prayer Pope Leo Wrote (Not that Leo... and not that one, either)

"Why do we say that prayer to the Archangel Michael after we're dismissed from Mass?"



Great to know you're reading this! These Little Liturgical Lessons respond to feedback from parishioners and Parish Staff. If you have questions about the Mass or other Sacraments—here or elsewhere—feel free to reach out!

Not long ago, we began our Inquiry sessions for OCI, where people prepare to enter the church. Many SJN parishioners came as possible Sponsors or Godparents for these Inquirers (we could use some more, by the way!). One of them asked me, "Why do we say that prayer to the Archangel Michael after we're dismissed from Mass? I don't hear it anywhere else!" First, it's important to know where that prayer came from.

Remember 1870? What a year! America was starting to heal from Civil War. Our British neighbors to the north had recently organized as modern Canada, and Europe had a minor dispute that erupted into the *Franco-Prussian War*. That conflict – which ended the First Vatican Council early, and set the stage for World War I – became so intense that some nice Italian named Garibaldi got a few thousand friends together to grab territory from what was then called the *Papal States*. Garibaldi wanted to unite Italy as a modern nation, but as the name implies, the owner of that desired land – Pope Leo XIII – got a bit nervous. In an attempt to bring peace to Europe (not to mention his own backyard), Leo took prayers first written by Pope Pius IX and asked the Universal Church to include them at the end of Sunday Masses. This included three Hail Marys, the *Salve Regina*, a verse and response, a prayer for the conversion of sinners and the liberty and exaltation of the Church, and finally the invocation of the Archangel Michael.

Fast forward to 1929. The unified Italians (under some nice guy named Mussolini) signed the *Lateran Treaty*, which created what is now the sovereign Vatican City State. The head of the "new, improved" territory – Pope Pius XI – chose not to end the use of the *Leonine Prayers* but changed the intention, for "the conversion of Russia" so that the Soviet Union might again permit freedom of worship, for oppressed Catholics and Orthodox alike. These prayers remained as a part of regular Catholic practice until they were officially suppressed (ended) in 1965, as a result of the Second Vatican Council (*Inter Œcumenici*, 48 j).

So...how did this prayer end up in present-day Sunbury? Like the Universal Church, the devotional behavior of this community after the celebration of Mass has evolved. Practices – always well-intentioned – came and went. A recent pastor thought it well to end Sunday Mass with the now-familiar remnant of the Leonine Prayers, and ending our Daily Masses with the *Divine Praises*, itself written for traditional evening prayers and often used for worship of the Holy Eucharist outside the context of the Mass.

As for Leo XIII, he became better known for a letter he wrote about the poor condition of laborers in the midst of the Industrial Revolution, *Rerum Novarum* ("The New Things," 1891). This began what is now modern Catholic Social Teaching, inspiring a Chicago-born Robert Cardinal Prevost to take his name upon being elected Pope earlier this year. But the *original* Leo – Leo the Great (440-461) may have been a better inspiration, having saved Europe from a much *more* destructive power than Garibaldi – a non-Italian named Attila the Hun!


