

Middle School, Grades 6 - 8

01 OUR PROGRAM

We are excited to welcome you to our Middle School Program! This program is for 6th - 8th graders and is designed to help students begin preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, which for most, will happen in 8th grade. We will meet once per month on Youth Ministry Night for dinner, prayer, church teaching, a dynamic message, discipleship, and small group times, all led by missionaries from Damascus Catholic Mission Campus!


02 OUR GOALS

Our program is designed to meet the educational, spiritual, emotional and social needs of young adolescents. Our program seeks to work cooperatively with families as you continue to build upon your child's faith formation and navigate this new stage of spiritual development. We strive to foster a transforming spiritual experience of Jesus through the liturgy, allowing early adolescents to experience the Word of God and the Eucharist in a deeper and more profound way. We want to create a positive experience of the Catholic Church for early adolescents, assisting middle school youth in gaining a deeper understanding and appreciation of what the Catholic Church teaches and believes. We help to incorporate the Catholic Church's vision of social justice and peace into the spiritual life of pre-adolescents.

03 WHEN WE MEET

Our Middle School program meets on the **second Sunday of every month, September - April, from 6:00 - 8:00 pm** in the Faith & Family Center.

Confirmation students will attend a day-long retreat in September, and Confirmation parents should expect to attend 1-2 parent meetings throughout the school year. Please see page 5 of this brochure for more information about Confirmation.



Sacramental Preparation

FIRST RECONCILIATION

The Sacrament of First Reconciliation is usually received in second grade; registration in the Family of Faith program is needed. Preparation involves "coaching" parents to form their own children. Topics center around how Jesus invites us each to a loving relationship with Him; how we can grow in that relationship and how we can seek forgiveness when we sin. There are a total of 6 parent-child classes that meet on designated Sundays from October-December after the 9:00 am Mass.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

The Sacrament of First Holy Communion is usually received in second grade; registration in the Family of Faith program is needed. Preparation involves "coaching" parents to form their own children. Topics center around how Jesus invites us to each Mass; how He prepares us to receive Him in communion and how we are empowered by the Mass to go out and change the world. There are 6 parent-child classes that meet on designated Sundays from February-April after the 9:00 am Mass.

CONFIRMATION

The Confirmation program is for 8th graders or those who are older who have not yet been confirmed. We meet once per month for Youth Ministry Night, which includes dinner for 6-8th grade. These youth ministry nights will be run by Damascus Missionaries and will consist of a night of prayer, church teaching, dynamic message, discipleship, and small group time to process. There will also be quarterly meetings to focus on the Sacrament of Confirmation. Preparation will include an opportunity for service in and for our community, a day retreat, and an afternoon with the Confirmandi and his or her sponsor.









High School Youth Ministry at St. John Neumann is very well-rounded! On Sunday evenings, teens will encounter the love of Christ and His Church in a large group setting. The missionaries from Damascus are leading Sunday evenings along with some of our Core Team from St. John Neumann. Outside of Sunday evenings are many opportunities to grow in discipleship, service, and leadership. These extras are where our teens get to grow more deeply in their relationship with Christ and our community here at St. John Neumann in a small group setting.
