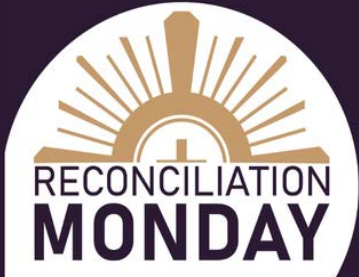

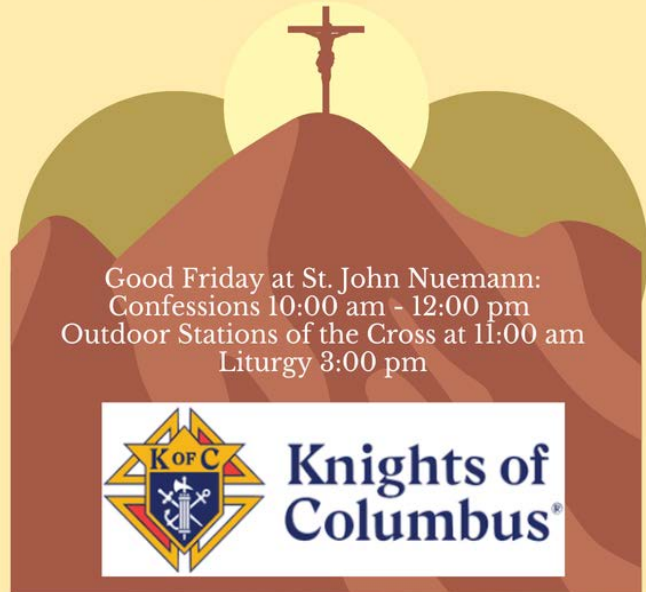

Little Liturgical Lessons

A Missive About Dismissals

One question Catholic liturgy nerds like me often ask about Mass—not to mention the clergy and occasional Mass-goers—is worth discussing here: *When is this over, and when can we leave!?!?* Since the end of Mass is a part of the Mass itself, what does it mean?

The 2010 *General Instruction to the Roman Missal* (GIRM) shows that after the Final Blessing and Dismissal, the celebrant/priest and deacon kiss the altar, and all the ministers make a profound bow to the altar and completely exit the sanctuary (90, 169). At that point, the faithful are encouraged to finish singing the Recessional Hymn (if there is one), make any prayers of thanksgiving to the Lord (95-97), and then quietly depart. The *Dismissal* at the end of Mass isn't a formality. It's when we as Church reveal the full dynamism of the Eucharist: a mystery not only received, but to be lived. The GIRM emphasizes that the Concluding Rites "send the people forth to put into effect in their lives what they have received" (90). In other words, the end of Mass is the "hinge" between *worship* and *mission*, between the altar and the world. The gathered Church becomes a sent Church.

The words of the Dismissal itself—such as "Go forth, the Mass is ended" or "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord"—have theological weight. The Latin *Ite, missa est* ("Go, you are all sent") conveys departure and mission; the term *missa* shares its root with "mission." Pope Benedict XVI highlighted this connection, himself having written two new versions of the Dismissal and noting they express "the missionary nature of the Church" and reveal that the Eucharist "never ends" but continues in the life of the faithful.

Within the Mass itself, two groups have been permitted to leave the Assembly sooner, after they have been called together by the celebrant and "commissioned," usually for study of the Scripture that best suits their needs. One group is for children not yet at the age of formation for First Communion, for what's known as "Children's Liturgy of the Word" (CLoW). A *Lectionary for Masses with Children* for U.S. dioceses was published for this in 1993. It uses a different version of the Bible than that proclaimed at Mass (the 1991 *Contemporary English Version* instead of the 2011 *New American Bible, Revised Edition*). These children are dismissed after the Collect (Opening Prayer), and ultimately rejoin the Assembly at the Preparatory Rites.



"Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord"

The other group is for those aged seven and above who are preparing for Baptism, the *Catechumens* (known after the First Sunday of Lent as *The Elect*). This is derived from the Second Century practice of "sending out" those who have not yet been admitted to receive Holy Communion. Prior to Vatican II (1962-65) the Mass was known as having the *Liturgy of the Catechumens* for the readings and preaching, and the *Liturgy of the Faithful* for the Eucharistic Prayer. Catechumens can be dismissed prior to the reciting of the Creed, which they do not yet proclaim until just before they are baptized, usually on Holy Saturday morning. In 2024 the U.S. Bishops called these Dismissals "praiseworthy," but they are not required (U.S. *National Statutes for Initiation*, Norm 10).

At SJN, neither of these groups are dismissed during Mass, and for a good reason: One of the best teaching tools we have about the Mass is the Mass itself. By allowing young children and those seeking the Sacraments of Initiation to attend and celebrate with us (albeit without joining the Communion Procession and remaining at their seats at that time), the habits of a worshipping community can be taught more readily. In the early centuries of the Church, dismissals of Catechumens protected the Faithful from the very real dangers posed by persecutions of Christians at the time. Of course, we are blessed with freedom of worship in this country and are also given the means of public safety and security.

And so, we permit the young and the uninitiated to join us. By doing so, we become missionary disciples in our own spiritual house, welcoming "those who fear the Lord (to) bless the Lord" (Psalm 135:20). And together we will "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord" by our lives.
