


Approximately four times a year, SJN volunteers provide meals and overnight **hosts for one week at the home in Delaware.** The dates for 2024 are:


This is a great opportunity for families to provide service together, especially because many of the clients also have young children.

### MAGNIFY THE LORD

Capital Campaign at St. John Neumann

We are so grateful for the generosity of all who have given to the Magnify the Lord Campaign thus far. You already may have noticed the recently installed confessionals and/or the beginning of our Marian Grotto. When Mary appeared to St. Juan Diego in Mexico and St. Bernadette in France, she asked that a shrine be built in her honor, ultimately in order to lead people to her Son. This is our hope as well: to lead others to Jesus through Mary. The grotto area will include a statue of Mary, an altar for Mass, a crucifix, candles, pavers and landscaping. This will be a gift pleasing to Our Mother.

The next phase of the grotto is to install the statue of St. Bernadette. The cost of this part of the campaign is \$20,000.

St. Bernadette was born in Lourdes, France on January 7, 1844. On Thursday, February 11, 1858, fourteen-year-old Bernadette was sent with her younger sister and a friend to gather firewood when a very beautiful lady appeared to her above a rose bush in a grotto called Massabielle (Tuta de Massavielha). The woman wore blue and white and smiled at Bernadette before making the sign of the cross with a rosary of ivory and gold. Bernadette fell to her knees, took out her own rosary, and began to pray. Bernadette later described the woman as "uo petito damizelo," meaning "a small young lady." On February 18, Bernadette said "the vision" asked her to return to the grotto each day for a fortnight. With each visit, Bernadette saw the Virgin Mary and the period of daily visions became known as "la Quinzaine sacrée," meaning "holy fortnight." During her sixteenth vision, which Bernadette claimed to have experienced for over an hour, was on March 25. Bernadette claimed she had asked the woman her name, but her question was only met with a smile. Bernadette asked again, three more times, and finally the woman said, "I am the Immaculate Conception." Bernadette asked the local priest to build a chapel at the site of her visions and the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Lourdes is now one of the major Catholic pilgrimage

sites in the world.




