




Share Your Musical Gifts at Mass!





LITURGICAL LESSONS



WHERE ARE WE LOOKING AT MASS?



At my house we have a set of windows that face precisely east. I can watch the Sun break over the horizon and through the windows - on the left side during the warmer months, and eventually from the far right in winter. During the day, our Dachshunds bask in the sunlight, and our houseplants flourish. Occasionally I can take the light in while thanking God for another day. Light gives life. Living things need it.

In the first decades after the time of Jesus, Christians imitated the practices of their Jewish forebears by turning to the rising sun in the east (*oriens*), in prayer and in weekly celebration of the Eucharist, giving thanks to Christ who became known as the "Sun of Justice" (*sol justitiae*). Sunrise, a powerful symbol found in scripture (Malachi 4:2; Zachariah 6:12; Psalm 67; Psalm 78:34), remains a daily visual reminder of the Resurrection (Luke 1:78). The person leading the liturgy would join the people in their *orientation* (turning east) – toward the living God. This posture of worship remains with us today. Presider and people "look east" (*ad Orientem*) in the Latin West, as they have in the Orthodox East along with their Eastern-Rite Catholic kin.

Prior to the Second Vatican Council (1962-65), altars in nearly all churches were attached to the Tabernacle, where the Blessed Sacrament is reserved and reverenced. Laypeople and clergy alike faced the Eucharistic Lord as their focal point. After the Council, the Church called for the Tabernacle to be separated from the altar-table, and even in large churches for it to be reserved in its own chapel for prolonged Adoration. This led many to believe the priest-presider should face the people (ad populum) from the other side of the table; based on archaeological evidence - which in the 21st Century is no longer seen as valid. While well-intentioned, it led over time to what theologian Joseph Ratzinger (later Pope Benedict XVI) called a "closed circle," a group of people addressing one another, as opposed to the practice of being opened to God!

The Roman Missal, believe it or not, doesn't call for the priest to face the congregation at all, except for certain moments at Mass. In fact, the documents of the Council didn't address this, or call for any changes. So - what happens *now*? Don't be surprised as many in the Church in the West take a new look at an ancient tradition that's rooted not in separating the laity and the clergy, but bringing all into unity, "in pilgrimage toward the Kingdom, invoked in prayer until the return of the Lord" (Congregation of the Eastern Churches, Il *Padre Incomprehensibile*, 1996).






