

WHEN WE ARE SENT...

At the conclusion of Mass, we are sent forth with the call to "go and announce the Gospel of the Lord" or to "glorify the Lord with your life." This isn't just a ritual phrase—it's a real commission!

The Word has been proclaimed to us, and the Real Presence of Christ, having been on the altar, now goes with us into the world. It's our turn to carry Jesus Christ beyond the church and into our daily lives. (And to think some people say Mass is "boring"!)

REFLECT FOR A MOMENT:

What Word will you carry with you when you leave Mass? What will stay with you when you get home? What message will you share with others throughout the week? The Gospel is not meant to stay within the walls of the church. It is a living, breathing message we are called to spread—like pollen in springtime! More importantly, when we receive Holy Communion, we become living tabernacles of the Blessed Sacrament. We are not merely receiving Christ; we are becoming vessels of His Real Presence. This calls us to a higher standard of discipleship. We become Tabernacles—so let's show it! Let our actions, words, and lives reflect the sacredness we now carry within us.

As we leave Mass, remember: our mission is just beginning. We are called to be Christ's hands and feet in the world, bringing Him to everyone we encounter. Embrace this mission with joy and dedication, knowing that we are never alone. Christ is with us, guiding and empowering us to be His disciples in every aspect of our lives.
