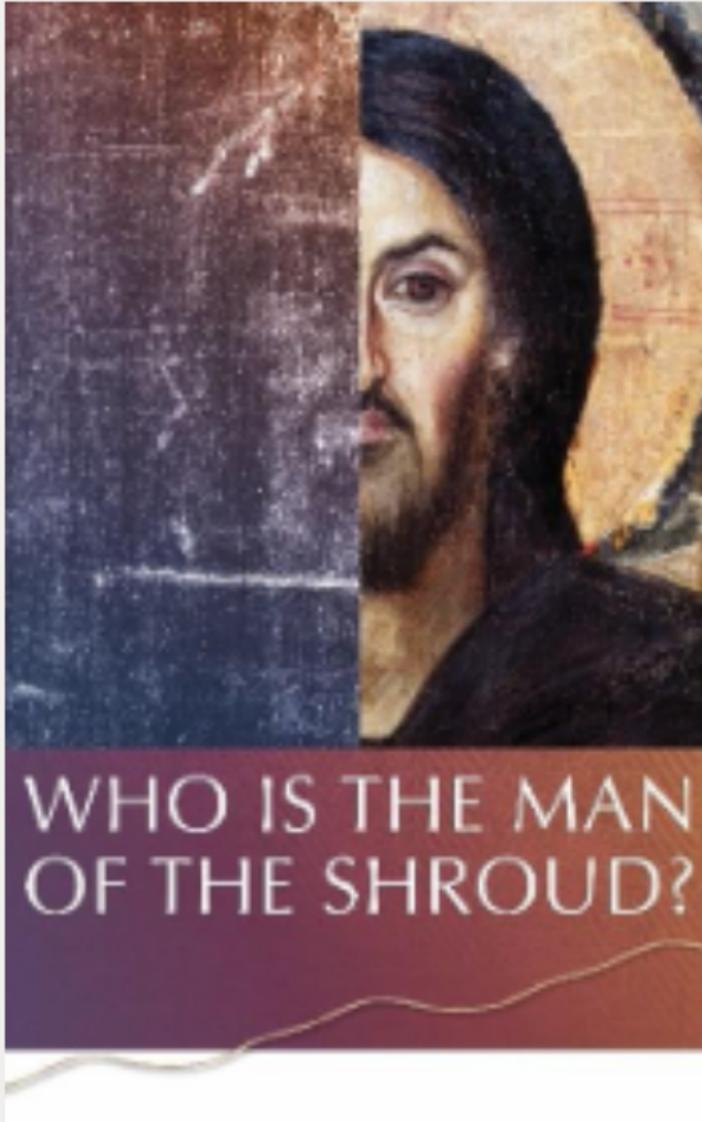

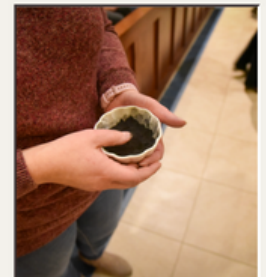

WHY DO WE USE INCENSE AT MASS?

The use of incense at Mass dates back to pre-Christian times and holds spiritual symbolism.

Incense, made from aromatic resins and gums derived from plants, has been used in various ceremonies to create an atmosphere of reverence and sanctity.

At Mass, incense has several purposes. It creates a sense of mystery and solemnity, **enhancing** the sacredness of liturgical celebrations. The fragrant smoke **engages** another sense of the members of the assembly, allowing them to participate more "fully, actively, and consciously." It symbolizes the **presence of God and the divine**, reminding those present that they are participating in a heavenly reality. It is used to **bless and purify** the altar, the assembly, and the objects used at Mass.

This purification echoes the rituals described in the Old Testament, where incense was used to **sanctify spaces and objects** dedicated to God's service. One of the earliest scriptural references to the use of incense is found in Exodus. God instructs Moses to create an altar for burning incense: "You shall make an altar to burn incense upon; of acacia wood shall you make it" (Exodus 30:1). This altar, placed before the Ark of the Covenant, was used exclusively for offering incense, symbolizing the prayers of the people rising to God. It reminds us that our worship and petitions are **lifted up to the divine throne**, creating a tangible **connection between heaven and earth**.

The Psalms also highlight the meaning of incense. Psalm 141:2 says, "Let my prayer be counted as incense before you, and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice." Here, incense represents the prayers and supplications of the faithful, ascending to God as **a pleasing fragrance**.

Incense in the Mass, then, is rooted in Scripture and Tradition and carries profound **spiritual significance**. It is a powerful symbol of purification, reverence, and the ascent of our prayers to God, enriching our liturgical experience and drawing us closer to the divine presence.
