



ST. JOHN NEUMANN (SJN) CONFERENCE - SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL (SVDP) ANNUAL EXPENSE SUMMARY

As Jesus said, "Whatever you do for the least of my brothers, you do unto Me" (Matthew 25:40). Your prayers and financial support of the St. John Neumann Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) are deeply appreciated.

In the past fiscal year, donations—including parish envelopes, grants, and Walk for the Poor sponsorships—increased by 6%. This generosity enabled us to continue serving those in need through personal interviews, prayer, bill assistance, and referrals to other resources.


The chart below shows how we used our funds from October 1, 2023, to September 30, 2024:

- **80%** (\$110,458) was directed to Assistance Intake, including rent/mortgage, utilities, bill payments, and "twinning" (sharing funds with other SVDP conferences).
- **20%** supported our other ministries: Senior Groceries (monthly food for low-income housing residents), Prison Ministry (Bible studies and post-release support), Big Walnut Friends Who Share, Family Promise, and more.

We thank God for your support, which allows us to serve and uplift those in need. All are welcome to join us in service and spiritual growth at our meetings, held every 4th Monday (except December) at 7 PM in Room 3 below the Faith and Family Center (FFC).



Join us for the Blessing of the Bells with Bishop Earl K. Fernandes, followed by a Mass of Thanksgiving at our usual 11:00 am Mass time.

What to Expect:

- The Bishop will bless the newly anointed bells in a special 15-minute ceremony.
- All are welcome to attend the blessing and the Mass of Thanksgiving that will follow.



SIGNIFICANCE OF THE BELLS

The rite for the blessing of bells illuminates their sacramental power. Sacramentals are anything set apart or blessed by the Church for the intention of guiding us to the sacraments and sanctifying our lives. Bells lead us to the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist by calling us to worship at Mass. In addition, the solemn blessing of bells indicates their role in casting away evil spirits and even protecting the faithful from deadly storms. This is a gift to God and a sacramental leading people to greater holiness.
