The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics in the United States on Monday, December 9, 2024. This is because the feast day is moved from December 8, to Monday, December 9, as December 8 falls on the Second Sunday of Advent.

DECEMBER 15

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

"Rejoice: the Lord is nigh." As Christmas draws near, the Church emphasizes the joy which should be in our hearts over all that the birth of our Savior means for us. This day is known as Gaudete Sunday. The term Gaudete refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon, "Rejoice." Rose vestments are worn to emphasize our joy that Christmas is near, and we also light the rose candle on our Advent wreath.

ADVENT ANTIPHON MASS ENTRANCE

This Advent at the 4:00 pm and 9:00 am Masses, we will begin by chanting the Entrance Antiphon. These weekly texts follow the themes of the Mass like the weekly readings. They are a tool to better understand the readings for that liturgy and are sung like our psalms. A cantor will sing the verses while we reflect on the theme and the lighting of the Advent wreath. Please join in the refrain printed in our hymnals by date. Come, Emmanuel!

We have been blessed to receive two grants in the current Responsive Grants Cycle distributed by The Catholic Foundation this year.



Inviting Those Who Are Seeking


