





# LITURGICAL LESSONS



# WHAT DO I DO WITH MY HANDS? (PART ONE)

# Why does the priest lift his hands during the Lord's Prayer, and I don't?

Remember 2023? In that year, Fr. Paul Keller, a Dominican priest who serves our Diocese as the Director for the Office of Divine Worship, was asked to explain what the Diocese now teaches on the beginning of the Communion Rite at Mass, namely, the Lord's Prayer. In short: The presiding priest lifts his hands in prayer, while the assembled laity and ministers either keep their hands at their sides, or join them in the front.

Fr. Keller clarified that gestures and postures used during Mass are not arbitrary—they're governed by *rubrics* (directions printed in *red* in the Missal, hence the name) to help ensure unity, reverence, and theological clarity. One such posture is the *orans* position, where hands are extended upward in prayer. While this gesture has ancient roots and is often seen in private devotion, its use during the Lord's Prayer at Mass is reserved for the priest alone. To drive the point home, Fr. Keller cited a 1994 letter from Rome that addressed the distinctions of the clergy and the laity, and why confusion between the two isn't helpful.

Raising hands or holding a neighbor's hands during the Lord's Prayer became popular in some communities during the 1970's, but was never incorporated into the liturgical norms. By the 1990's the Bishops in the U.S. chose to let individual dioceses give guidance about this time during the Mass. The concern that came from past "flu seasons" and even the recent pandemic led some to overlook the *orans* by the faithful to avoid handholding.

While well-intentioned and even sentimental, such gestures introduce misunderstanding or distraction, especially when they vary from parish to parish. Liturgical prayer – the *public work* of prayer - is meant to be communal and unified, not individualized or even worse, abused.

Acting in *persona Christi* (in the person of Christ), the priest leads the congregation in prayer and offers the Sacrifice of the Mass on behalf of the Assembly. His raised hands during the Lord's Prayer symbolize his role as intercessor, gathering the prayers of the faithful and lifting them to God. The assembled laity, by contrast, are not instructed in the rubrics to raise their hands at this moment. Instead, they are encouraged to adopt a posture of prayer that reflects unity and humility—typically with hands folded or joined.

Moreover, the Church emphasizes symbolic clarity in the celebration of the liturgy. When the laity begin to mimic a priest's gestures, it can blur the distinction between their given roles. This isn't about hierarchy or place or power—it's about preserving the integrity of the function of each vocation. They are represented with distinctness, and therefore, the entire liturgical assembly is more inclusive than one may realize.

Catholics refrain from raising their hands during the Lord's Prayer at Mass not because the gesture is "wrong," but because our liturgy calls for specific roles and postures that foster unity, reverence, and theological coherence.
