



WHAT IS MARY'S MEALS?

The Mary's Meals campaign was born in 2002 when Magnus visited Malawi during a famine and met a mother dying from AIDS. When Magnus asked her eldest son Edward what his dreams were in life, he replied simply: "I want to have enough food to eat and to go to school one day."

That moment was a key part of the inspiration which led to the founding of Mary's Meals, which began by feeding just 200 children in Malawi in 2002. Today, they feed 2,429,182 hungry children every school day across 17 countries.

The charity is named in honor of Mary, the mother of Jesus, who brought up her own child in poverty.

IT COSTS \$25.20 TO FEED A CHILD FOR A YEAR.

We are raising funds for the school in Nansembe in the Blantryre area of Malawi – this is also where St. John Neumann has supported a water pump to be installed through Design Outreach.

There are 568 students.




