

# EMBRACING LENTEN MUSIC



As we continue the Lenten season at St. John Neumann—a season of penance, prayer, and preparation for Easter—our liturgical music intentionally shifts to reflect the Church's long-held traditions. These changes help us enter more deeply into the mystery of Christ's Passion and Resurrection.

One major change is moving from our familiar sung English Mass settings to chanted Latin versions of the Kyrie, Sanctus, and Agnus Dei. This connects us to the universal heritage of the Church, as Latin and Gregorian chant foster a sense of solemnity and timelessness, uniting us with generations of believers.

Our music also becomes more subdued and contemplative. The lively instrumental sounds of Ordinary Time give way to simpler melodies, minimal accompaniment, and sometimes acappella singing. This musical fasting mirrors Lent's call to simplicity, repentance, and interior conversion. Hymns and psalms take on a more penitential tone, preparing our hearts for the Paschal Triduum.

*These musical changes are a gift, drawing us closer to Christ. May we welcome them with open hearts this Lent.*

## Little Liturgical Lessons

# And now, the battle is joined.

We have begun the adventure of Lent. It is indeed *dura et aspera* - very challenging, but if done well, very liberating. May yours be supported by grace. Take note of the words of the *Collect* (Opening Prayer) at Mass over the next several weeks, and you'll notice that the Church will be there to support us...nobody makes their Lenten sacrifices alone!

Among us in our seasonal pilgrimage at SJN are literally *dozens* of people – men, women, children, across several age groups – making preparations for the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, in this ancient and traditional order) at either the Easter Vigil or the Vigil of Pentecost. It's hard to believe, but the planning for this time has begun in earnest.

When Lent draws to its close, the Church will turn her gaze toward the Paschal *Triduum*—the “three days” that begin at sunset on Holy Thursday and reach their radiant fulfillment in the Easter Vigil. These days are not simply the end of a liturgical season; they are the very heart of the Church's year, the summit toward which all Christian life ascends. For the *Elect*—those preparing for Baptism—this transition marks the final movement of a journey that has been unfolding for many months. Holy Saturday morning brings the *Preparatory Rites*, a quiet but profound moment in which the Elect profess the Nicene Creed for the first time and join the parish community in readying themselves for the mysteries that will soon transform their lives.

Everything converges on the Easter Vigil, to be celebrated this year on April 4 at 9:00 pm. In the deepening darkness of Holy Saturday night, the Elect will be soaked with the waters of Baptism, dying and rising with Christ in the most literal and sacramental sense. The Font – eight-sided to represent the “Eighth Day of Creation,” the Second Coming – will at once be a tomb for their former lives up to that moment, and a womb from which they will be born into new life in Christ. Emerging from the font, they will be anointed with Sacred Chrism in Confirmation, configured to Christ and strengthened by the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Their initiation reaches its high point when they receive the Eucharist for the first time—Christ's own Body and Blood—at the very liturgy that proclaims His Resurrection. The Church calls the Easter Vigil the “mother of all vigils” because it is here that the full drama of salvation is proclaimed, enacted, and received. For the newly baptized, it is nothing less than the beginning of a new creation.

Yet the Church's work of initiation does not end on that night. Fifty days later, on the Vigil of Pentecost—May 23 at 4:00 pm—another group will take their place in the unfolding story of grace. These are the Candidates: already baptized Christians who now seek full communion with the Catholic Church. Their path is different from that of the Elect, but their longing is the same: to be united fully to Christ and His Church. At the Pentecost Vigil, they will make a Profession of Faith, affirming publicly their desire to enter into the Church's sacramental life. Alongside Catholics who are completing their own initiation, they will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation and share in the Eucharist. (There will also be a handful of Baptisms as well!) Pentecost, the feast of the Spirit's outpouring, is a fitting moment for this celebration, for it reminds the whole community that the Spirit continues to gather, strengthen, and send forth disciples.

These weeks invite the entire parish to accompany both the Elect and the Candidates with prayer, encouragement, and joyful expectation. Like so many across our Diocese and around the entire world, their path toward the sacraments is a living sign of what the Church herself is always called to be: a people continually renewed by grace, continually reborn through the Paschal Mystery, and continually sent into the world as witnesses of Christ's transforming love.
