Other Keys for Preparation:

Pick a prayer partner: Help your teen pick a prayer partner – an adult in the parish that you ask to pray for your child throughout their preparation for Confirmation.

Pick a Sponsor:

The Confirmation Sponsor must be a confirmed, practicing Catholic at least 16 years of age. He/she cannot be a parent; however, the sponsor can be a grandparent or Godparent. This should be someone the candidate trusts in seeking out faith advice and direction. While the popular choice is a family member or family friend, we also recommend small group leaders and ministry leaders. But this is a choice up to the candidate.

Once your child picks a Sponsor:

- 1. Make sure they set aside February 4th from 2:00-4:00 pm for the Sponsor Day of Reflection
- 2. Ask them to pray for the candidate and to check in on their preparation
- 3. Give them the Sponsor Information form to complete and send to St. John Neumann Confirmation, 9633 E. State Route 37, Sunbury, OH 43074 due February 4, 2024.

Pick a Confirmation Saint Name:

In order to manifest the close relationship of Confirmation to Baptism, the candidates, according to the longstanding custom of the Church, may retain their baptismal name. However, a special name may be chosen if desired, in which case it should be that of a recognized saint of the Church, or a person from scripture (CF Canon #855.) For more information on Saints and biblical characters you can visit the Catholic Encyclopedia, www.newadvent.org/cathen

A Saint needs to be selected by January. Between January and March, your child will prepare an oral report on their Saint to present to their family or small group.

Service:

Jesus calls us to serve those in need. When you make an active commitment to follow Jesus, a part of that commitment is serving others. As such, a component of our program includes community service.

Candidates and their families are encouraged to seek 10 hours of service. You may serve in the community or you may serve your family, a neighbor, etc. The goal of this requirement is to foster a desire to continue to serve others, long after one is confirmed! Please return your completed service hour log form on April 7, 2024.

The Sacrament of Confirmation completes your child's initiation into the Catholic Church. If you allow the Holy Spirit to work in your life, this will be a year of transformation for your family. We pray that you are open to God, His gifts and plan for your life.

Please request Confirmation at St. John Neumann from Father Dury for your child by completing and returning the form below. There is no perfect answer, please be honest with yourself and God. Sponsor Information and Guidelines - Due February 4

To most Catholics, being asked to serve as a Confirmation sponsor is a real honor! Please don't feel like you are "putting someone out" by asking them to take on this important role. In selecting your sponsor, please consider the following guidelines:

- 1. Must be age 16 or older.
- 2. MUST be a fully initiated Catholic (one who has celebrated Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation and practices their faith).
- 3. May not be the candidate's mother or father.
- 4. Shares their faith story with his or her candidate and demonstrates a willingness to grow in the faith.
- 5. Provides spiritual guidance and serves as a companion and mentor to the candidate. The sponsor is willing to openly communicate with the candidate, helping the candidate with the questions and concerns that may arise as a result of the Confirmation process.
- 6. Attends the Confirmation Sponsor Day of Reflection/rehearsal and Confirmation Rite.
- 7. Prays for and with the candidate.
- 8. Sponsors continue to be there for the candidate and lend spiritual support after the Confirmation ceremony is over.
