Annual Expense Summary

The members of the SJN conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) wish to share our gratitude with the parish for your support of our service to the poor.


"No work of charity is foreign to the Society," but we depend on others to help us fulfill our mission.

Donations (parish envelopes, grants, Walk for the Poor sponsorship) increased again this past fiscal year. This allowed us to continue serving local individuals in need as the cost of rent, utilities, and food all increased. Your donations provided food and helped keep neighbors in their homes with working utilities. Your prayers allow us to "serve in hope."

The pie chart illustrates how our conference used our financial blessings from 10/1/24 through 9/30/25. 86% of our funds (\$138,633) were directed to Assistance Intake (AI): rent/mortgage, utilities, and other bill paying AND "twinning" (sharing funds with other SVDP conferences when the need was more than one conference could handle).

14% of our funds supported our conference's other ministries: "Senior groceries" (food given once monthly to residents of two low-income housing complexes in Sunbury); "Prison Ministries" (Bible studies and navigating life after release); Big Walnut Friends Who Share; Family Promise; and others.

We thank God for your role in making sure we can serve & support the needy in our community. Vincentians bear witness to the love of Christ in many ways, including their relationships with those in need. All are invited to join us in spiritual growth and service. 'tis Better to Light a Candle Than Curse...

The Season of Advent gives us a four-candle wreath (or similar item) to help us count down to the Season of Christmas. (EDITOR'S NOTE: It's not Christmas yet. Sorry, Hallmark!)

Candles in Catholic liturgy serve in practical and symbolic ways, rooted in biblical tradition and shaped by centuries of theological reflection and Church guidance. Dating back to our Jewish forebears, light has symbolized divine presence, truth, and salvation. Their use is not just decorative, but biblical and theological: "I am the light of the world," Jesus says (John 8:12). In the Old Testament, God commands Moses to keep a lamp burning continually in the Tabernacle: "The lamp shall be set up outside the veil... it shall burn continually before the Lord" (Exodus 27:20–21). This flame signified God's enduring presence among His people. Light is a metaphor for Christ Himself throughout the New Testament. The Gospel of John opens with: "The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it" (John 1:5). The use of candles in church reflects this truth—Christ as light, Who dispels spiritual darkness.

Candles were first simply practical—light sources for dark catacombs and churches. Over time, their symbolic value grew. By the Middle Ages, candles were required at Mass, especially during the reading of the Gospel, to signify the presence of Christ in the Word. The norms for candle use are outlined in the 2010 *General Instruction of the Roman Missal* (GIRM). "At least two candles are to be placed on or near the altar, and to be lit for all liturgical celebrations" (GIRM 117).

On solemn occasions, four or even six candles may be used, and seven for a Mass with a bishop. *The Ceremonial of Bishops* (§128) specifies their use in processions, particularly during the entrance, and the Gospel proclamation. Candles are also required during Eucharistic Adoration and Benediction. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops affirms that candles used in liturgy must be made of at least 50% beeswax and produce a simple, "living flame" without being smoky or artificial (such as oil lamps, scented candles, etc.). Electric or battery-operated lights are not permitted in place of candles during Mass, as they lack the sacramental symbolism of fire.

In contemporary liturgy, candles have multiple functions. The Paschal Candle, lit at the Easter Vigil, is the most prominent example. It represents the Risen Christ and is inscribed with the current year, the Alpha and Omega, and the cross. In fact, until 1955 the Easter Vigil could not be done at night - the proper time for a liturgical vigil - because of the number of candles a church would need for illumination. (Yay for electricity!) The Paschal Candle is lit throughout the Easter season and at Baptisms and funerals, signifying the light of resurrection.

Candles are integral to sacramental celebrations such as Baptisms and funerals. The "unity candle," once done at weddings, has no connection at all to the Roman liturgical tradition (Sorry, Hallmark!). In devotional life, candles are used in processions (e.g., Candlemas), during Eucharistic Adoration, and in personal prayer. The flickering flames of *votive candles* invite contemplation and reverence.

Candles embody a liturgical principle: a physical sign that conveys greater spiritual realities. Their use in our liturgy is not arbitrary, but rooted in our Church's understanding of how material elements can mediate grace. As Pope Benedict XVI noted in *Sacramentum Caritatis*, the "art of proper celebration" includes attention to such signs, which foster active and fruitful participation. Candles remind the faithful of their baptismal vocation to be "light of the world" (Matthew 5:14). Their presence in our church is a visual call to holiness, mission, and witness.
