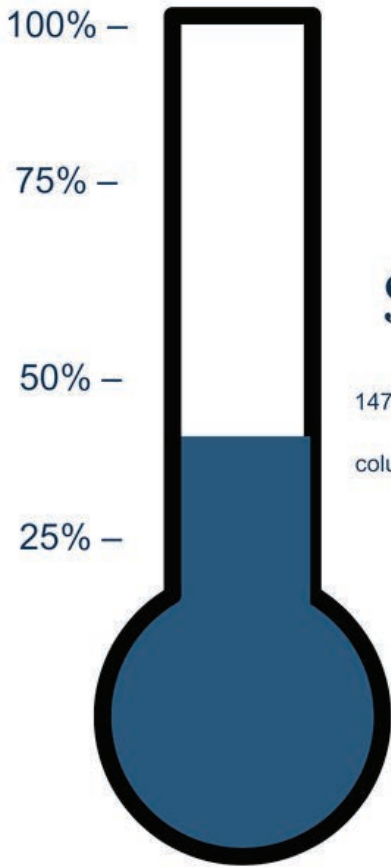

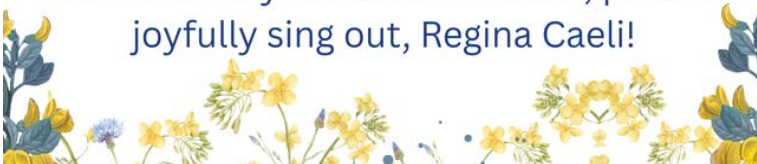
REGINA CAELI

What Parts of the Mass Are Optional—and What Aren't

Since the Fourth Century, the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord, a holy day of obligation to attend Mass, has been celebrated on a Thursday – 40 days after the Resurrection, and ten days until Pentecost. So why is it being celebrated here and other places on a *Sunday*?

Catholic bishops in the United States received permission in 1999 to transfer the Ascension to Sunday, and many dioceses adopted the change in the early 2000s. Not everyone did, however, and so this particular feast day (not to mention the Seventh Sunday of Easter) is one of the more confusing bits of our existing liturgical calendar.

The U.S. bishops cited three reasons for this shift. First, many Catholics found it difficult to attend Mass on a Thursday because of work and school obligations. Moving the feast to Sunday ensured a greater participation in a major solemnity. Second, in large or rural dioceses where one priest often serves multiple parishes, adding a Thursday holy day created significant strain. Finally, Sunday is already the Church’s “foremost holy day of obligation,” making it a fitting day for a solemnity that is already well-tied to the Paschal mystery. Decades after this innovation came to pass, calls to “Make Ascension Thursday Again” are far and wide, and several American dioceses have done so, especially where there are ample priests and resources to celebrate this worthily on a Thursday.

On that note...when people ask each other, “Why do we do *that* at Mass?” they’re usually asking a deeper question: *Is this required, or is this just how our parish does it?* Others may attend Mass at a parish nearby or some other place, and get surprised by parts put in – or taken out! The celebrations of our liturgy contain fixed elements – those things required everywhere – and optional elements that allow for adaptation. Knowing the difference can help us appreciate both the *unity* of the Church’s worship while also understanding the legitimate *diversity* we see from parish to parish.

Some parts of the Mass are essential because they come directly from our Church’s universal liturgical law. In fact, the ritual books for each of the Sacraments contain the Church’s law on liturgy by themselves, which makes them reliable guides. Each one includes guidelines in the front text (the *praenotanda*), often called the *General Instruction* for how that Sacrament is celebrated.

The *General Instruction of the Roman Missal*, which you can find in the very first pages of that ginormous book you see on the Altar at Mass, is our first major guideline. It states “The Order of Mass is to be observed in all celebrations of the Eucharist” (28). You might think that would be a given, but it has to be mentioned *explicitly* to have what we call “force of law.” This Order includes:

- **Proclamation of the Holy Scriptures** (always including a Gospel),
- **A Homily** on Sundays and holy days,
- **The Eucharistic Prayer**, with all the required elements (epiclesis, institution narrative, anamnesis, etc.),
- **The Words of Consecration**, which may *n-e-v-e-r* be altered,
- **The Lord’s Prayer**, with its *embolism* (that part the priest says right afterward),
- **The Sign of Peace**, though its *exchange* can be adapted, and of course,
- **Holy Communion**, under at least the form of bread.

These elements aren’t subject to personal preference or local custom or some charismatic, “ad lib” creativity. In fact, “no other person, not even a priest, may add, remove, or change anything in the liturgy on his own authority” (*Sacrosanctum Concilium* 22). Other elements of the Mass, however, are *intentionally* flexible. These allow the liturgy to respond to “on-the-ground-level” pastoral needs, cultural contexts, and the spiritual character of a particular celebration. For instance:

- **The Penitential Rite.** The priest may choose one of three forms, or replace it with the Blessing and Sprinkling of water upon the Assembly.
- **The Gloria.** Required on Sundays outside Advent and Lent, this can be omitted on weekdays and penitential seasons.
- **The number of readings.** On weekdays, two readings are required; on Sundays, three.
- **The Eucharistic Prayer.** The priest may choose one from *ten* approved prayers, each with its own theological emphasis. The Roman Canon (E.P. I) is the longest; E.P. II is both the shortest *and* the oldest such prayer.
- **Postures and gestures.** Some of these vary by national conferences of bishops (for example, kneeling after the *Sanctus* in the United States, or standing after the Memorial Acclamation in Canada).
- **Music selections.** While the texts of liturgical songs must be approved by proper authority, the style and repertoire (a parish’s “collective memory” of song) can vary widely.
- **The Sign of Peace.** The invitation is required, but the manner of exchange is adaptable.

These options are not loopholes or improvisations – they are built into the Roman Rite. These options allow pastors and liturgical ministers to make choices that serve the spiritual good of the community. The GIRM emphasizes this pastoral responsibility: “The priest... should consider the common spiritual good of the people of God, rather than his own inclinations” (352). In other words, options exist not for personal preference, but for the sake of the faithful.
