# SAINT JOHN NEUMANN: SHEPHERD FOR IMMIGRANTS AND BUILDER OF FAITH

## FEAST DAY JANUARY 5

On January 5, the Church celebrates the feast of St. John Neumann, CSSR, our parish's patron.

Saint John Neumann (pronounced NOY-man in Europe and most places in the United States) was a missionary bishop whose life helped shape Catholic life in the United States. His story is one of quiet determination, pastoral zeal, and a deep love for the people entrusted to his care—especially the poor, the immigrant, and the forgotten.

John Nepomucene Neumann was born on March 28, 1811, in Prachatice, Bohemia—today part of Czechia. Raised in a devout Catholic family, he learned early the rhythms of prayer and service. His mother's daily Mass attendance and the family's simple piety planted in him a desire for the priesthood. After studies at the University of Prague, Neumann felt a growing call to missionary work. Europe had more priests than parishes at that time; America, by contrast, had vast Catholic populations with almost no clergy to serve them. He applied for ordination, but when his bishop delayed the process, Neumann made a bold decision: he would sail to the United States with no guarantee of ordination, trusting that God would open the right doors.

He arrived in New York in 1836 with a single suitcase and a heart ready for mission. Bishop John Dubois ordained him that same year, sending him to minister to scattered immigrant communities around Niagara Falls. His parish territory stretched hundreds of miles, and he often traveled on foot through harsh winters to bring the Sacraments to isolated families. These years reveal the heart of Neumann: tireless, uncomplaining, and committed to the spiritual welfare of ordinary people.

In 1842 he entered the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer—the Redemptorists—becoming the first man to profess vows in the order in the United States. Religious life gave him the community he longed for and the structure to continue his missionary work. He served as pastor, novice master, and eventually provincial superior, known for his simplicity, frugality, and fatherly care.

Neumann's life took a dramatic turn in 1852 when Pope Pius IX appointed him the fourth Bishop of Philadelphia. He accepted reluctantly, aware of his own limitations, but he embraced the office with the same spirit that guided him since his arrival in America. Created as its own diocese in 1803 - along with New York, Boston and Bardstown (later Louisville) - Philadelphia at the time was a rapidly growing city filled with Catholic immigrants—Irish, German, Italian, and others—who faced poverty, discrimination, and limited access to education.

One of his greatest contributions was the expansion of the Catholic school system. He founded or built nearly 100 schools during his eight years as bishop, laying the foundation for the modern parochial (parish) school network in the United States. He believed deeply that Catholic education was essential for forming disciples and preserving the faith in a new land. His efforts earned him recognition as a pioneer of Catholic education in America.

Neumann also organized new parishes, welcomed religious communities to the diocese, and introduced the Forty Hours' Devotion, fostering Eucharistic love and parish renewal. He visited his parishes constantly—often surprising pastors by arriving unannounced—and insisted on preaching and hearing confessions in the languages of his people. His pastoral letters reveal a bishop who saw himself not as an administrator but as a shepherd who longed to be close to his flock.

On January 5, 1860, while running errands in the city, Bishop Neumann collapsed and died at the age of 48. His death shocked the diocese, but his legacy continued to grow. He was beatified in 1963 and canonized in 1977, becoming the first male American citizen to be declared a saint. His incorrupt body lies under glass at St. Peter's Church in Philadelphia.

Saint John Neumann stands as a model for the Church today: a missionary disciple, a builder of communities, a champion of Catholic education, and a shepherd who "smelled like the sheep" long before the phrase became popular. His life reminds us that holiness is found not in grand gestures but in daily fidelity—walking long miles, learning new languages, listening to the needs of the poor, and trusting that God can multiply our small offerings into abundant grace. May his example inspire us to serve with the same humility, courage, and missionary heart.




