





Does Language Matter?

Not long ago, one of our deacons chanted Kyrie Eleison ("Lord, have mercy") at a Sunday Mass. A parishioner later asked, "Why do we still use Latin at Mass? What about Vatican II?"

Good question—though Kyrie Eleison isn't Latin, but Greek, the same language commonly spoken during Jesus' time. People used Greek in everyday life, Latin for official matters, and their native tongue at home. Our "church Latin" came a bit later but was also once a widely spoken language. While not common today, Latin remains important in theology, law, science, and philosophy.

After the Second Vatican Council (1962–65), the Church encouraged use of the vernacular (local language) in the liturgy. Still, Vatican II never abolished Latin. In fact, the Council stated that Latin "is to be preserved in the Latin rites" (Sacrosanctum Concilium 36), and encouraged the faithful to learn parts of the Mass in Latin (SC 54).

At SJN, we honor this tradition by using Latin during the Eucharistic Prayer in Advent and Lent. (And yes—there's one other time Greek is used in a liturgy. Can you guess when?)

The Roman Catholic Church is officially known as the Latin Rite—Latin is our liturgical heritage and spiritual birthright. That said, our liturgy today can be celebrated in many languages, based on the Roman Missal, Third Edition (2010), which guides the Mass worldwide. This shouldn't be confused with the older Tridentine or Traditional Latin Mass, which dates to the 16th century and is celebrated occasionally with a bishop's permission. That older form gave way to the revised, vernacular Mass following Vatican II.

Some believe that the use of Latin at Mass prefigures a return to that older form of the Mass, or other former ways of doing things. Not so! We are privileged to worship in both Latin and our native language, usually English. In fact, in 2001, Pope St. John Paul II emphasized that translations should remain faithful to the Latin original—leading to the revised English Mass in 2010.

By the way – it's during the Commemoration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, one of the most dramatic points in the Great Triduum – that we hear Greek again: during the Good Friday liturgy, in the form of the Trisagion:

Agios o Theós, Agios iskhūrós, Agios āthánatos, eléison hēmâs ("Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us").




