

We're happy to welcome Fr. Elias Udeh!
Born in Enugu, Nigeria, Fr. Elias is the third of five children.
His father was a civil engineer, and his mother worked in
textiles and taught women to make and sell clothing.
After attending technical college, he worked at a
Mercedes-Benz plant before beginning seminary studies
in 2001.

He studied philosophy and theology at Spiritan institutes affiliated with the University of Nigeria-Nsukka, earning a master's degree in theology in 2012. Fr. Elias was a member of the Spiritans (Congregation of the Holy Spirit), a missionary order founded in France in 1703, now serving in over 60 countries. His ministry has included service at St. Anthony Parish in Nigeria and missionary work among the poor in Brazil.

Now a priest of the Diocese of Columbus, he brings with him a deep missionary spirit and a global perspective.






Use of Funds



Annual Expense Summary






Thank you for your prayers and generous support of the SJN Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul. Because of your kindness, donations (from parish envelopes, grants, and Walk for the Poor sponsors) increased by 6% this past fiscal year. These gifts allowed us to serve those in need through person-to-person outreach, prayer, financial assistance, and connections to vital resources. From October 1, 2023 to September 30, 2024, we directed:

• 80% (\$110,458) toward direct aid: rent, utilities, other urgent bills, and "twinning" support for neighboring conferences facing overwhelming need.




